CBSE final bord exams started on February 27th. 18 students appeared for exam it is the first batch of our school under CBSE syllabus registered from our school

13. TEACHERS TRAINING PROGRAMS


During this academic year our teachers had participated in many training programs both online and offline. They had participated in the programs which was conducted by CBSE as well as the programs which was conducted by the state government.

14. CLASS X RESULT


